Re: Exemption from Requirement to Hold a Communications Operating Licence


In reference to your application dated December 17, 2013 regarding the above mentioned. After review, the Regulatory Authority (RA) has concluded that the service offered by Ex-PAT TV (EPTV) is considered a value-added service and exempt from the obligation to hold a Class Operating Licence pursuant to the RA's General Determination on Communications Operating Licences: Exemptions and Class Licences dated 29 April 2013.

You are referred to Section 5 of the attached obligations of EPTV exemption holders. Violation of these obligations may result actions being taken against you and possible revocation of the exemption. The RA reserves the right to review your service offering in 1 year from the date of this correspondence.

Please note that this exemption does not alleviate, transfer or remove in any way the responsibility for you to abide by and adhere to all intellectual property laws and obligations both within Bermuda and those that affect Bermuda internationally. .
