# PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING

**In the Matter of Enforcement Proceedings**

**TeleCommunications Networks Limited**

**A. WHEREAS:**

1. In accordance with section 93(3) of the Regulatory Authority Act 2011 (“the RAA”), the Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (“the Authority”) seeks to determine, by conducting an informal adjudication, whether TeleCommunications Networks Limited (“TNL”) contravened certain statutory provisions, requiring the payment of fees to the Authority.
2. The Authority wishes to advise the public that the captioned enforcement and adjudication hearing is to commence forthwith in accordance with the provisions and procedures set out in the RAA and the “Regulatory Authority (Adjudication Rules) General Determination 2014” (“the Rules”) made pursuant to section 74(2) of the RAA, (available at [www.bermudalaws.bm](http://www.bermudalaws.bm) and [www.ra.bm](http://www.ra.bm)).
3. **B. ANY PERSON SEEKING TO INTERVENE IN THIS PROCEEDING MUST FILE A WRITTEN REQUEST:**

- within 5 business days of the publication of this Notice, (Rule 4 (1));
- containing the following information, (Rule 4 (2)) -
  - (a) the petitioner's name and address;
  - (b) the petitioner's interest in the proceedings;
  - (c) the petitioner's position(s) with respect to the matters in controversy;
  - (d) whether the petitioner proposes to broaden the issues in the proceeding and if so, a statement of the proposed issues; and
  - (e) the name and address of the petitioner's representative, if any; and
- to which the IPO shall promptly give notice of the decision granting, denying, or modifying the said request to the petitioner and to all parties, (Rule 4 (6)).
