

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (the “Authority”) has received notification of a proposed change of control with respect to Quovadis Services Limited (“Quovadis”) whereby 51% of the issued share capital will be transferred to WISEKey Bermuda Holding Limited (“Holding”) (the “Proposed Transaction”).

Pursuant to section 18(6) and 18(7) of the Electronic Communications Act 2011 and section 18 of Quovadis’ Communications Operating Licence (“COL”), the Authority (acting with the written consent of the Minister) hereby issues this Final Decision and Order giving authorization for the Proposed Transaction.
