Dr. Keith Chiappa, who will act as a consultant to the advisory panel, is a Bermudian Rhodes Scholar who was educated at Harvard University and Oxford University. Dr. Chiappa has 40 years of experience in the human central nervous systems as a neurologist with a special interest in neurophysiology. He also has additional experience in magnetic resonance imagining in humans, both clinical and research applications, and has contributed to and been published in dozens of medical journals and books.

Since 2011, Dr. Chiappa has worked for the Bermuda Hospitals Board as a neurologist and Director of the Clinical Neurophysiology Laboratory. He also served as Chief of Medicine (2008 – 2014) and Chief of Staff (2015 – 2017) for the Bermuda Hospitals Board. Dr. Chiappa was Associate Professor of Neurology at Harvard Medical School and Massachusetts General Hospital. He also served as Associate Director of the Clinical Neurophysiology Laboratory at Massachusetts General Hospital, where he worked from 1976-2010.
